



EVENT SUMMARY: Most orphanages today have water connections but we believe it is equally important to make sure the water they drink is pure. We found that kids at Sudheer Foundation are prone to many skin diseases and infections due to the storage conditions they have. So we got an RO water purifier installed and also got TDS(Total dissolved solids) water purity check done to make sure that the Bore water which gets purified by the RO purifier is now safe to drink. We also provided evening snacks for the kids.

We donated some electricals, cleaning items, skincare and first-aid kits, and indoor games for kids keeping in mind their mental health. We also got their water purifier repaired..

Event Summary: Washrooms are one of the most basic necessities, especially in orphanages with many kids. Lack of washrooms to use can lead to various health effects. We found such a case in Siria Homes, where not even a single washroom is in use. So we intend to do everything needed to get them all to use. We executed this in 3 phases - giving the drainage connection, establishing washroom fixtures, and fixing the electricals needed.

By this, we got 12 Washrooms to be ready for use.




