The Institute is located on 10.31 acres having 70 Blocks of buildings are present. The class room are spacious, well lit by natural light, well ventilated and equipped with projectors etc. The labs are spacious, clean and good layout.

(iii) Student Support System.

The Institute is a non-residential as it is well connected with bus transport. The institute has a health centre providing basic medical care. However, the students have a medical insurance of Rs 5.00 lacs, and there are 3 big hospitals in the close vicinity. Good sports facilities are present, with NCC, NSS, EDC and Unnat Bharat Abhiyaan, Cultural Society, and canteen (2 Nos).

leave to attend conference, seminars and RDP.


