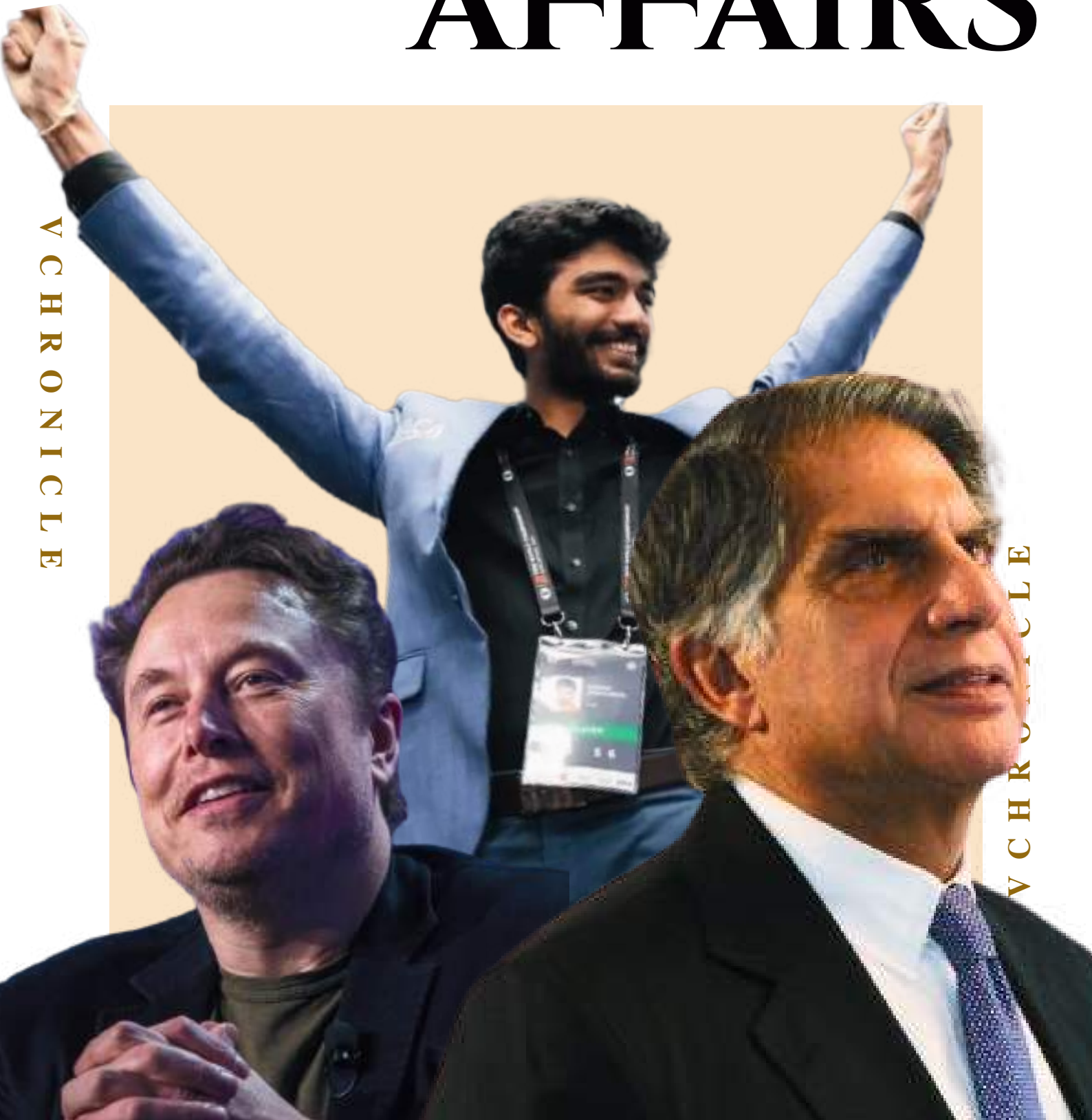

ELON MUSK'S VISION FOR SPACEX

The new era of space exploration has evolved into a dynamic competition involving both nations and private enterprises, moving beyond the state-run rivalry of the Cold War. This race is not just about national pride but about building a sustainable future in space, with countries like India emerging as significant players due to their innovative and cost-effective approaches. However, challenges such as the immense costs of space missions, the growing problem of space debris, and the ethical and geopolitical complexities of commercializing space highlight the need for international collaboration. Major contributors like Jeff Bezos' Blue Origin envision millions living and working in space through reusable rockets and space tourism, while Richard Branson's Virgin Galactic explores commercial suborbital flights for elite travelers. NASA's Artemis program is set to return humans to the Moon by 2025, paving the way for long-term lunar presence and future Mars missions.

INDIA'S SPACE PROGRAM – ISRO

ISRO has achieved global recognition with milestones like Mangalyaan, Chandrayaan missions, and the Chandrayaan-3 Moon landing. Future plans include the Gaganyaan human spaceflight, Chandrayaan-4 for further lunar exploration, and expanding Mars missions.



NASA AND THE PROGRAM FOR ARTEMIS

With plans to create a long-term lunar presence NASA's Artemis mission is set to send humans back to the moon by 2025. An important milestone in human space exploration is the Artemis program's goal of acting as a launchpad for upcoming Mars missions.

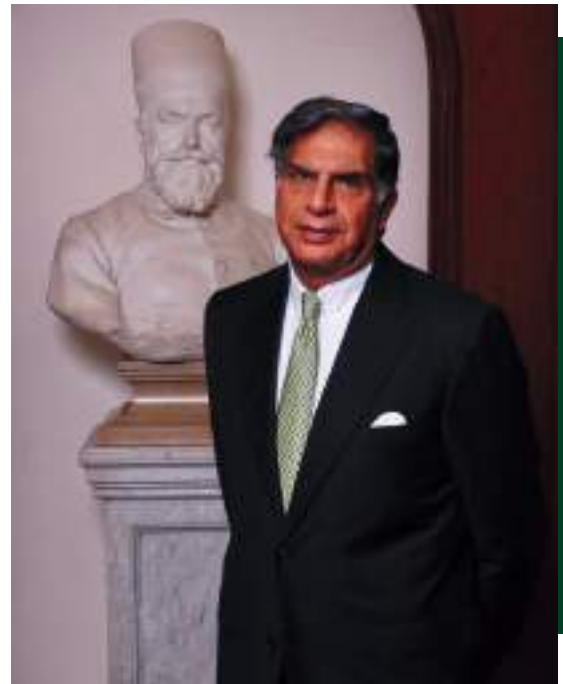
RATAN TATA : MILLENNIAL DUMBLEDORE

Early Life of The Corporate Titan:

Ratan Tata, born in Bombay into a Parsi family on 28th December, 1937. He is a member of the prominent Tata family, influential in Indian Business and Philanthropy. His parents, Naval Tata and Sooni Tata when he was young and hence he was raised by his grandmother, Lady Navajbai Tata. He graduated with a degree in Architecture from the prestigious Ivy League, Cornell University in 1962 and completed his education by Advanced Management Program at Harvard Business School in 1975.

The Start of His Career:

The Man with the Midas Touch joined the Tata Group in 1961 and began his career on the shop floor of Tata Steel in Jamshedpur, this was his foundation for understanding business. In 1991, he succeeded Appro JRD by becoming the chairman of Tata Group.



His Legacy:

Ratan Tata's tenure is marked by transforming the Tata Group into a global conglomerate with revenues of over \$100 billion. His leadership is still celebrated for his ethical practices, long-term vision and his commitment to community welfare.

He retired as the chairman in 2012 but remained active as Chairman Emeritus of Tata Sons, he also invested in startups like Ola, Urban Ladder and Lenskart, encouraging innovation in India.

The Indian Tycoon passed away on October 9, 2024, at the age of 86. His passing marked the end of an era, leaving behind his legacy of integrity, innovation and social responsibility inspiring the future generations of India.

His Accomplishments:

- International Expansion: Under his leadership, the Tata Group acquired global brands, such as:
- Tetley Tea: Acquired by Tata Tea in the year 2000 was made the second-largest tea producer.
- Corus Steel: Acquired by Tata Steel in the year 2007 was made one of the largest steel producers globally.
- Jaguar Land Rover: Acquired by Tata Motors in the the following year of acquiring Corus Steel, 2008, revived luxury car brands, boosting Tata Motors presence all over the world.
- Tata Nano: He launched the Tata Nano in the same year he acquired JLR, this car was marketed as the world's most affordable car, aiming at providing affordable transportation to millions of Indian families.
- Philanthropy: The Tata family, through Tata Trusts has donated extensively to healthcare, education and rural development. During Ratan Tata's tenure, Tata Trusts supported initiatives in cancer treatment, clean water and education.
- Recognition: He was honoured with India's second-highest civilian award, the Padma Vibhushan, in 2008, and the Padma Bhushan, in 2000.

THE CHESS PRODIGY, GUKESH DOMMARAJU

The Rook: Gukesh Dommaraju

Gukesh D. (Gukesh Dommaraju) is a young and highly talented Indian chess champion. Born on December 29, 2006, in Chennai, India.

His Most Recent Accomplishment

The 2024 World Chess Championship was held in November–December 2024 between Gukesh and Ding Liren. Gukesh scored three wins against two wins for Ding, and nine draws in the 14 classical rounds of the tournament. He won the 14th and final match on 12 December 2024, and as a result, the World Chess Championship by a scoreline of 7½–6½. The win made him the youngest undisputed World Chess Champion, with only Ruslan Ponomarev being slightly younger when Ponomarev won the FIDE World Chess Championship 2002, a knockout tournament when the title was split. FIDE commented on Gukesh's gameplay as having "near-perfect accuracy", and Ding reacted that it was his best tournament of the year, and that he had no regrets in losing the title to Gukesh. Accolades—and claims of credit—came from both Tamil and Telugu politicians, as well as congratulations from the Indian cricket world.

3. Commons Education Project (October 28th)

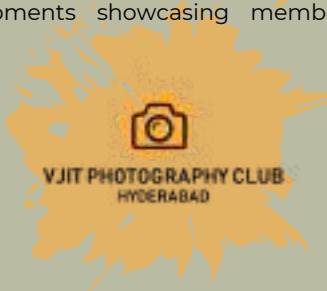
Preserved Gond tribal heritage by documenting the intricate costumes and energy of the Gussadi Dance.
