Sir/Madam,

This has reference to the proposal submitted by Vidya Jyothi Institute of Technology, Aziz Nagar Gate, CB Post, Hyderabad-500 075, Telangana affiliated to Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University, Hyderabad for extension of autonomous status under the UGC Scheme for Autonomous Colleges.

As per the decision of the Standing Committee constituted by University Grants Commission, in its meeting held on 22.10.2021, the Competent Authority has decided to extend the autonomous status to **Vidya Jyothi Institute of Technology, Aziz Nagar Gate, CB Post, Hyderabad-500 075, Telangana** affiliated to **Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University, Hyderabad** for a period of Five (05) years from the session 2021-2022 to 2025-2026, as per provisions of Clause 3.13 and Clause 6.3 of UGC Regulations dated 12.02.2018.

The University is requested to issue necessary notification/order regarding extension of autonomous status to the College as per the UGC (Conferment of Autonomous Status Upon Colleges and Measures for Maintenance of Standards in Autonomous Colleges) Regulations, 2018 for Autonomous Colleges. The College, if eligible, shall apply for autonomy grant as per the norms laid down in the Regulations.

The Autonomous College is required to abide by all the provisions of the UGC Regulations for Autonomous Colleges. The Regulations are available on the UGC website, www.ugu.ac.in. Non compliance of the requirements and conditions in the said Regulations shall attract action as per Clause -14 of the UGC Regulations – 2018. Further, it may be noted that the above said college shall also apply in the prescribed format to University Grants Commission for extension of autonomous status six months prior to the expiry of the autonomous cycle.

Further, your attention is invited to the clause 6.3 of UGC (Conferment of Autonomous Status Upon Colleges and Measures for Maintenance of Standards in Autonomous Colleges) Regulations, 2018 as given below:

: 2 :

"The colleges must be accredited by either NAAC with minimum 'A' Grade or by NBA for at least three programme(s) with a minimum score of 675 individually or a corresponding accreditation Grade/score from a UGC empanelled accreditation agency. However, if the number of programme(s) being run by the Institution is less than three, then each of the programmes should secure 675 or more marks. Accreditation status must be valid at the time of application.

Provided further, the existing autonomous colleges will be required to comply with this eligibility condition by 11th February, 2023 as per Clause of 6.3 of UGC, Regulations 2018.

The college is requested to take necessary action accordingly.

ORDER:

In the reference (1) read above, the University has forwarded the proposal to the UGC for grant of Extension of Autonomous Status to Vidya Jyothi Institute of Technology, Himayatnagar (V), Aziz Nagar Gate, CB Post, Hyderabad, Telangana, affiliated to JNT University Hyderabad.

In the reference (2) read above, the UGC has conferred Autonomous Status to Vidya Jyothi Institute of Technology, Himayatnagar (V), Aziz Nagar Gate, CB Post, Hyderabad, affiliated to JNT University Hyderabad, Kukatpally, Hyderabad, Telangana, for a period of Five (05) Years from the Academic Year 2021-22 to 2025-26 as per provisions of Clause 3.13 and Clause 6.3 of UGC Regulations dated 12.02.2018 and requested the University to issue conferment orders as per UGC (Conferment of Autonomous Status Upon Colleges and Measures for Maintenance of Standards in Autonomous Colleges) Regulations 2018 for Autonomous Colleges and subsequent regulations issued from time to time by the University.

Also, the UGC has stated that the autonomy granted colleges shall abide by all the provisions of the UGC Regulations for Autonomous Colleges. The college shall apply, in the prescribed format to the UGC, for extension of autonomous status six months prior to the expiry of the autonomous cycle.

Further, the UGC stated that the clause of 6.3 of UGC (Conferment of Autonomous Status Upon Colleges and Measures for Maintenance of Standards in Autonomous Colleges) Regulations, 2018 as given below:

The colleges must be accredited by either NAAC with a minimum of 'A' Grade or by NBA for at least three programme(s) with a minimum score of 675 individually or a corresponding accreditation Grade/score from a UGC empaneled accreditation agency. However, if the number of programme(s) being run by the Institution is less than three, then each of the programmes should secure 675 or more marks. Accreditation status must be valid at the time of application.

Provided further, the existing autonomous Colleges will be required to comply with this eligibility condition by 11th February 2023 as per clause of 6.3 of UGC Regulations 2018. The College is requested to take necessary action accordingly.

Under the circumstances as stated above, the Vice-Chancellor is pleased to approve the conferment of Extension of Autonomous Status to Vidya Jyothi Institute of Technology, Himayatnagar (V) Aziz Nagar Gate, CB Post, Hyderabad, affiliated to JNT University Hyderabad, Kukatpally, Hyderabad, Telangana, for a period of Five (05) Years from the Academic Year 2021-22 to 2025-26 as per provisions of Clause 3.13 and Clause 6.3 of UGC Regulations dated 12.02.2018, subject to ratification by the Standing Committee of the Academic Senate and Executive Council. RECOMMENDATIONS

The committee recommends Conditional Grant of Autonomy to the college with effect from academic year 2016-17 subject to fulfilment of the following conditions and an undertaking to this effect by the Management & the Principal:

1. Recruitment of qualified faculty at Professor and Associate Professor level as per AICTE norms and scales in all the UG & PG programs of the engg. Branches.
2. Enhanced Level of preparedness and awareness of the scope and implementation of autonomy to be created among the stake holders at all levels.
3. A well defined document with approval of Devolution & Delegation of authority of both Financial and Administrative powers by the management at all levels from the Principal to HoDs, and other functionaries needed for enabling autonomy.
4. Committee strongly feels that there should be no increase in intake or new UG/PG programs initiated, till the existing programs are stabilised for at least the next 3 years.
5. A well defined Budget planning and allocation process to be implemented
6. Augmentation of the library resources with special provision for PG and R&D.
