**Revised Tuition fee as per the High Court orders date:19/05/2026 IA NO.2, of 2026 IN  
WP no.19116 of 2026 of High Court of the State of Telangana.**

As per the Interim order issued by Honorable High Court for the state of Telangana.

- a) Vidya Jyothi Institute of Technology is permitted to collect Rs.1,15,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Fifteen Thousand Only) tuition fee for the Academic Year 2026-2027. Pending disposal of the present writ petition.
- b) Prospective students seeking admission into Vidya Jyothi Institute of Technology for the academic year 2026-2027 the tuition fees payable by the students may be increased to Rs.1,42,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Forty Two Thousand Only) subject to outcome of the writ petitions.

Therefore, the students seeking admission into Vidya Jyothi Institute of Technology have to pay the balance of tuition fees of Rs.19,800/- apart from fee reimbursement.

CHANDRA SHEKAR REDDY, Standing Counsel for TAFRC for the Respondent no.2 and GP FOR EDUCATION for the Respondent no.1, the Court made the following

#### **ORDER**

**These applications are moved through lunch motion seeking to modify the order, dated 19.06.2026 passed by this Court in I.A.No.2 of 2026 in W.P.No.19116 of 2026 and I.A.No.3 of 2026 in W.P.No.19117 of 2026.**

Heard Mr. Sirgapoor Sahil Reddy, learned counsel for the petitioners and Mr. G.Chandra Shekar Reddy, learned Standing Counsel for TAFRC.

Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and for the reasons stated in the accompanying affidavit, the Registry is directed to substitute paragraph Nos.8 and 10 of the interim order, dated 19.06.2026 passed in I.A.No.2 of 2026 in W.P.No.19116 of 2026 and I.A.No.3 of 2026 in W.P.No.19117 of 2026, which read as follows:

*“On the strength of the above submissions, learned Senior Counsel prayed this Court to permit the petitioners-institutions to collect the fee fixed for the previous block period i.e., A.Y. 2022-23 to 2024-25 i.e., Rs.1,15,000/- in W.P.No.19116 of 2026 and Rs.1,35,000/- in W.P.No.19117 of 2026, pending disposal of the present writ petitions and further requested this Court to direct the Conveners, TGEAPCET and TGECET, to display in the official website that the fees of Rs.1,15,000/- in W.P.No.19116 of 2026 and Rs.1,35,000/- in W.P.No.19117 of 2026, which was fixed for the previous block period i.e., A.Y. 2022-23 to 2024-25 may be increased to Rs.1,42,000/- and Rs.1,65,000/- respectively, which was tentatively approved by TAFRC during the personal hearings conducted on 10.03.2025 and 25.02.2025 respectively for the block period from A.Y. 2025-26 to A.Y. 2027-28, subject to the result of the present writ petitions and communicate the same to prospective students seeking admission into the petitioners-institutions for A.Y. 2026-27.*

*Having regard to the submissions made by the learned Senior Counsel appearing for the petitioners, in view of the law laid down by the erstwhile High Court of Andhra Pradesh in the aforesaid judgment and considering the fact that the counselling process has already commenced, as an interim measure, this Court is inclined to issue following directions:*

*(i) The petitioners-institutions are permitted to collect the fee fixed for the previous block period A.Y. 2022-23 to 2024-25 i.e., Rs.1,15,000/- in W.P.No.19116 of 2026 and Rs.1,35,000/- in W.P.No.19117 of 2026 for the A.Y. 2026-27, pending disposal of the present writ petitions.*

*(ii) The Conveners, TGEAPCET and TGECET, are directed to display on the official website that the fees to be collected per student is Rs.1,15,000/-*

*and Rs.1,35,000/- in W.P.Nos.19116 and 19117 of 2026 respectively and the said fees may be increased to Rs.1,42,000/- and Rs.1,65,000/- in W.P.Nos.19116 and 19117 of 2026 respectively, for the A.Y. 2026-27, subject to the outcome of the present writ petitions.*

*(iii) The Conveners, TGEAPCET and TGE CET, shall communicate the present interim order to the prospective students seeking admission for the A.Y. 2026-27 into the petitioners-institutions."*

**The Registry is further directed to issue a modified copy of the order forthwith.  
Accordingly, both the applications are allowed.**
