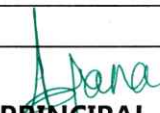

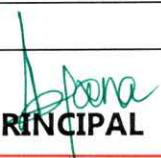

The Chairperson of the Academic Council, **Dr. A. Srujana, Principal, VJIT**, welcomed all the members and introduced the new JNTUH nominees to the Council: **Dr. T. Venugopal, Professor of CSE, JNTUH UCERS; Dr. P. Sammulal, Professor of CSE, JNTUH UCESTH; and Dr. K. H. Phani Shree, Professor of EEE, JNTUH UCESTH.**

She expressed her sincere gratitude to the outgoing Academic Council members, **Dr. O. B. V. Ramanaiah, Senior Professor of CSE, JNTUH; Dr. M. V. S. S. Giridhar, Professor of CEA & WMT; and Dr. A. Rajani, Professor of ECE, JNTUH UCESTH**, for their valuable suggestions and contributions during previous Academic Council meetings, which significantly benefited the institution.

Principal thanked all the members for their presence in the meeting and initiated the Proceedings of the meeting as per the agenda circulated:

Item No. 1: To note and ratify the Action Taken Report (ATR) on the resolutions of the 26th Academic Council Meeting held on 24th September 2025

The Principal presented the Action Taken Report on the resolutions approved during the 26th Academic Council Meeting and informed the members of the following:

- The Academic Regulations (R-25) approved by the Academic Council have been implemented for all B.Tech and MBA programmes with effect from the Academic Year 2025–26.
- The approved course structures and syllabi under R-25 Regulations for B.Tech I Year and MBA I Year have been implemented from the Academic Year 2025–26.
- The syllabi approved by the respective Boards of Studies and ratified by the Academic Council are being implemented for B.Tech and MBA students admitted from the Academic Year 2025–26.
- The Results Processing Committee approved by the Academic Council has processed and finalized the results of all Regular and Supplementary Examinations conducted during the Academic Year 2025–26.



- The Value Added Courses (VACs) ratified by the Academic Council have been offered and conducted by various departments.
- A total of 3,559 student completions were recorded in the Value Added Courses conducted during the Academic Year 2025–26.

The members appreciated the progress achieved and noted the implementation status of the resolutions approved by the Academic Council.

Resolution: Noted and ratified.

Item No. 2: To consider and approve the recommendations of the Boards of Studies pertaining to:

2.1 B.Tech II Year Curriculum (I and II Semesters) under R-25 Regulation

The Principal presented the recommendations of the Boards of Studies relating to the B.Tech II Year curriculum under R-25 Regulation.

- Dr. T. Venugopal, University Nominee enquired about the course structure of B.Tech CSE under R-25 Regulation and reviewed all the courses in the Course structure.
- The Council reviewed the proposed curriculum, course structures, and syllabi for B.Tech II Year under R-25 Regulations.

The Council appreciated the proactive measures taken by the institution for introducing emerging technology courses and strengthening faculty preparedness.

2.2 B.Tech Minor Programmes under R-25 Regulation offered by CSE & ECE dept.

The Principal presented the recommendations of the Boards of Studies relating to the Minor Degree Programmes under R-25 Regulation.

- The course structures and curricula of the Minor Degree Programmes in Quantum Computing and Internet of Things (IoT) were presented before the Council.



- Dr. M. V. Krishna Murthy, Member sought clarification regarding the availability of software tools, laboratory facilities, and infrastructure required for their effective implementation.
- Details of the Quantum Computing laboratory curriculum and infrastructure were presented. Dr. D. Aruna Kumari, HOD CSE informed that the laboratory component would be delivered through simulation-based platforms utilizing Python libraries and IBM Quantum simulation tools.
- Dr. T. Venugopal suggested including the software tools used in the Quantum Computing Minor Programme in the syllabus and enquired about faculty preparedness for offering the courses.
- In this connection, the Principal informed the Council that faculty members of CSE and IT Departments had undergone FDPs and have completed NPTEL Certifications also in Quantum Computing to support effective programme implementation.

2.3 M.Tech Programmes of various departments under R-26 Regulation

The Principal presented the recommendations of the Boards of Studies M.Tech programmes under R-26 Regulation. The council reviewed the curriculum proposed for M.Tech programmes under R-26 Regulation.

2.4 B.Tech Courses offered by MBA Department under R-25 Regulation

The Principal presented the recommendations of the Boards of Studies relating to the MBA courses offered to B.Tech students under R-25 Regulation.

- The Council reviewed the courses proposed by the MBA Department for offering to B.Tech students under the Open Elective category.
- Dr. U. Balaji, Member suggested introducing courses that would enhance the managerial, entrepreneurial, financial, and business acumen of engineering students, thereby improving their industry readiness and career prospects.
- Further he opined that the Open Elective course “Banking and Insurance” may have limited relevance to B.Tech students and suggested considering more employability-oriented alternatives.



- Dr. T. Venugopal opined that the inclusion of Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) is already prescribed as a mandatory course under JNTUH regulations and suggested that the MBA Open Elective basket may be reviewed and suitably revised.

The Principal informed the Council that the MBA Department would examine the suggestions made by the members and place the revised recommendations, if any, before the next Board of Studies meeting for consideration.

Resolution: Noted and approved

Item No. 3: To consider and approve new Academic Regulations for implementation from the Academic Year 2026-27

3.1 M.Tech under R-26 Regulation

The Principal presented the draft Academic Regulations of M.Tech(R-26) Regulation proposed for implementation from the Academic Year 2026–27 and placed them before the Council for consideration and approval.

- The Council reviewed the proposed M.Tech (R-26) Regulations in detail.
- Dr. K. H. Phani Shree, University Nominee, informed the Council that Clause 7.18 pertaining to mandatory publication had been deliberated extensively at JNTUH, and a decision was taken to remove the requirement to avoid the possibility of publications being pursued solely for compliance rather than quality.
- Dr. M. V. Krishna Murthy opined that publication of research papers may require considerable time and that a mandatory publication requirement could lead to delays in programme completion.

After deliberations, the Council resolved to remove Clause 7.18 from the draft Academic Regulations. However, publication of research work may be encouraged by the supervisor based on the quality and relevance of the work.

Resolution: Noted and approved.



3.2 Minor Degree Regulation under R-25 Regulation

The Principal presented the draft Academic Regulations for Minor Degree Programmes under R-25 Regulation proposed for implementation from the Academic Year 2026–27. She further informed that the R-25 Regulation are in line with JNTUH Minor Regulation.

The Council reviewed the status of the Minor Degree Programmes offered by the institution.

- The Principal informed the members that all 83 students enrolled during the Academic Year 2024–25 had successfully completed the programme requirements and that there were no enrolments during the Academic Year 2025–26.
- Dr. K. H. Phani Shree enquired about enrolments in Minor Degree Programmes, particularly in Electrical and Electronics Engineering and Mechanical Engineering. The Principal clarified that enrolments were limited due to low student demand and would be reviewed periodically based on student interest and industry relevance.

Resolution: Noted and approved.

Item No. 4: To consider and approve the grant of one-time opportunity for Mid and Semester Examinations

4.1) B.Tech students admitted in Academic Years 2015-16 & 2016-17

4.2) M.Tech & MBA students admitted from Academic Years 2015-16 to 2022-23

Principal presented the proposal for granting One-Time Opportunity to students under various regulations for appearing in Mid and Semester Examinations in accordance with the JNTUH notification vide Letter No. Lr.No./DUEX/OLE/1611 dated 17.04.2026 regarding the conduct of Special Supplementary Examinations (One-Time Chance).

- The applicable regulations for the proposed One-Time Opportunity include R15, R18, R19, and R20.
- Dr. P. Sammulal, University Nominee sought clarification regarding the eligibility criteria and applicable regulations. The Principal informed the Council that the



institution would strictly adhere to the guidelines issued by JNTUH while conducting the examinations.

Resolution: Noted and approved.

Item No. 5: To consider and approve the conduct of Advanced Supplementary Examination for IV B.Tech II Semester students of R-22 Regulation.

Principal informed the Council that the conduct of Advanced Supplementary Examinations would provide an opportunity for students of IV B.Tech. II Semester with backlog courses to clear their pending subjects and complete the programme requirements without delay, thereby facilitating their academic progression and career pursuits.

The Principal further informed the Council that students admitted under earlier regulations who have not cleared IV B.Tech II Semester courses would also be permitted to appear for the Advanced Supplementary Examinations, as separate supplementary examinations are not conducted for IV B.Tech II Semester courses.

Resolution: Noted and approved.

Item No. 6: To consider and approve the norms pertaining to revaluation and recounting for B.Tech, M.Tech and M.B.A Programmes.

The Principal informed the Council that JNTUH had issued guidelines for Autonomous Colleges regarding Recounting (RC) and Revaluation (RV) vide Proceedings No. DUEX/Guidelines for Autonomous Colleges of JNTUH/2025, dated 27.10.2025, to ensure uniformity, transparency, and consistency in the evaluation and result processing system.

The Principal proposed the adoption of the JNTUH norms for Recounting (RC) and Revaluation (RV) for all B.Tech, M.Tech, and MBA programmes. She further proposed that any future guidelines issued by JNTUH in this regard shall be implemented by the Institute in toto.

Resolution: Noted and approved.

Item No. 7: To consider and approve the constitution of the Results Processing Committee of the Examination Branch for processing and publication of examination results.

Principal proposed the constitution of a new Results Processing Committee of the Examination Branch for timely publication of examination results.

Resolution: Noted and approved.

Item No. 8: To consider and approve the Academic Calendar for the Academic Year 2026-27 for: B.Tech, M.Tech and MBA Programmes.

The Principal presented the Academic Calendars of II , III , IV Year B.Tech, II Year M.Tech and II Year MBA for the Academic Year 2026–27, which were prepared in accordance with the applicable academic regulations and in line with the guidelines issued by JNTUH.

The members sought the information about I Year BTech, MTech and MBA calendars.

The Principal informed the Council that the Academic Calendars for I Year B.Tech, I Year M.Tech, and I Year MBA programmes had not yet been released by JNTUH and requested the Council to authorize the Principal to prepare and implement the Academic Calendars in line with the JNTUH Academic Calendars upon their release.

Resolution: Noted and approved.

Item No. 9: To apprise the Academic results of UG & PG programmes for the Academic Year 2025-26.

The Principal presented the results of the B.Tech I Semester, M.Tech I Semester, and MBA I Semester Examinations for the Academic Year 2025–26.

- The Council reviewed the academic performance of the various programmes.
- The members observed that greater academic focus is required at the first-year and second-year levels to improve the overall pass percentage.
- The Council recommended identifying subjects with lower pass percentages and implementing appropriate corrective measures to enhance student performance.



- The departments were advised to prepare and document action plans and present the corresponding Action Taken Reports in future Academic Council meetings.

The Principal informed the Council that necessary actions would be initiated based on the suggestions and recommendations made by the members.

Resolution: Noted.

Item No. 10: To note and ratify the minutes of the 15th IQAC Meeting held on 2nd January 2026.

Principal requested Dr. A. Padmaja, Dean – Rankings and Accreditations, to present the Minutes of the 15th IQAC Meeting held on 2nd January 2026.

- Dr. A. Padmaja presented the Minutes of the 15th IQAC Meeting and highlighted the major quality enhancement initiatives undertaken by the institution through the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC).
- She also informed the Council that VJIT had been placed in the **NIRF 200–300 Rank Band** under the Engineering Category and briefed the members on the initiatives undertaken towards institutional ranking and accreditation.

The Council reviewed the activities and initiatives undertaken by IQAC during the period under consideration and appreciated the progress achieved.

Resolution: Noted and ratified.

Resolution: Noted.

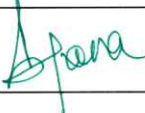
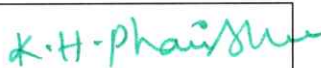
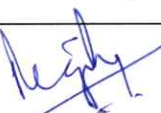
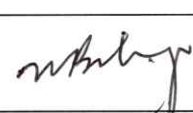
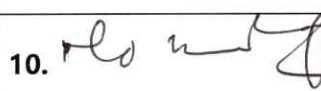
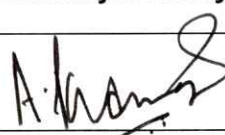
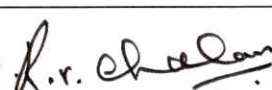
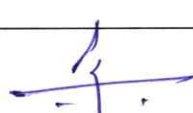
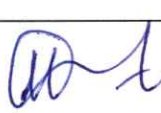
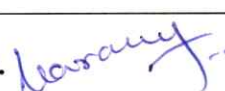
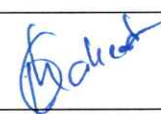
Item No. 16: Any other matter with the permission of the Chair.
